

LIGHTING NEW MANTLE

- 1. Tie mantle around the groove in burner cap and cut off extra string.
- 2. Distribute the fabric evenly around the burner cap.
- 3. Light bottom of mantle evenly with match.
- 4. Let mantle burn until only ash remains.
- 5. Allow mantle to cool several minutes after it burns off.

MAINTENANCE

- 1. Generator should last 100-200 hours.
- 2. Clean Generator Tip with Pricker on wrench after 50-55 hours operation (do not use Pricker unnecessarily).
- 3. When replacing Generators remove protecting Cap and
- 4. Wash Fount out with gasoline when changing Generator.
- When attaching new Mantle distribute folds evenly.
- 6. Keep Pump Leather soft with light oil. PRECAUTION: Always provide good ventilation, particularly when burning leaded gasoline.






